

It is often the consequence of factors extending beyond an individual's control. Social issues are the source of a conflicting opinion on the grounds of what is perceived as morally correct or incorrect personal life or interpersonal social life decisions.

Sustainable development can be defined as development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.

- The environment also sustains life by providing **Bio diversity. The genetic variations** created by the pressures exerted by the environment on various life forms allows those life forms to adapt, evolve and produce genetic variations which can survive in harsh environments
- A pollutant is a waste material or substance which causes An undesirable change in a
 natural resource or ecosystem. Smoke, dust and poisonous gases in the atmosphere and
 industrial effluents and sewage from cities in water are some common examples of
 pollutants.
- **Soil degradation** refers to an undesirable or deleterious change or disturbance in the quality of the soil. It leads to a change in the species of plants and animals in an area, and often leads to a loss of quality and productivity of the soil in an area due to
 - a. Excessive use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides,
 - b. Waterlogging in Uttar Pradesh, Punjab
 - c. Overgrazing by animals in fields Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra
- **Habitat degradation** refers to the process in which habitats lose their normal functioning or quality to support native life due to human activities.
 - a. Deforestation
 - b. Agricultural land Urban expansion of natural habitats
 - c. Soil erosion and desertification, which can lead to whole forests degenerating into deserts.
 - d. Land degradation in Punjab , Haryana, Uttar Pradesh
