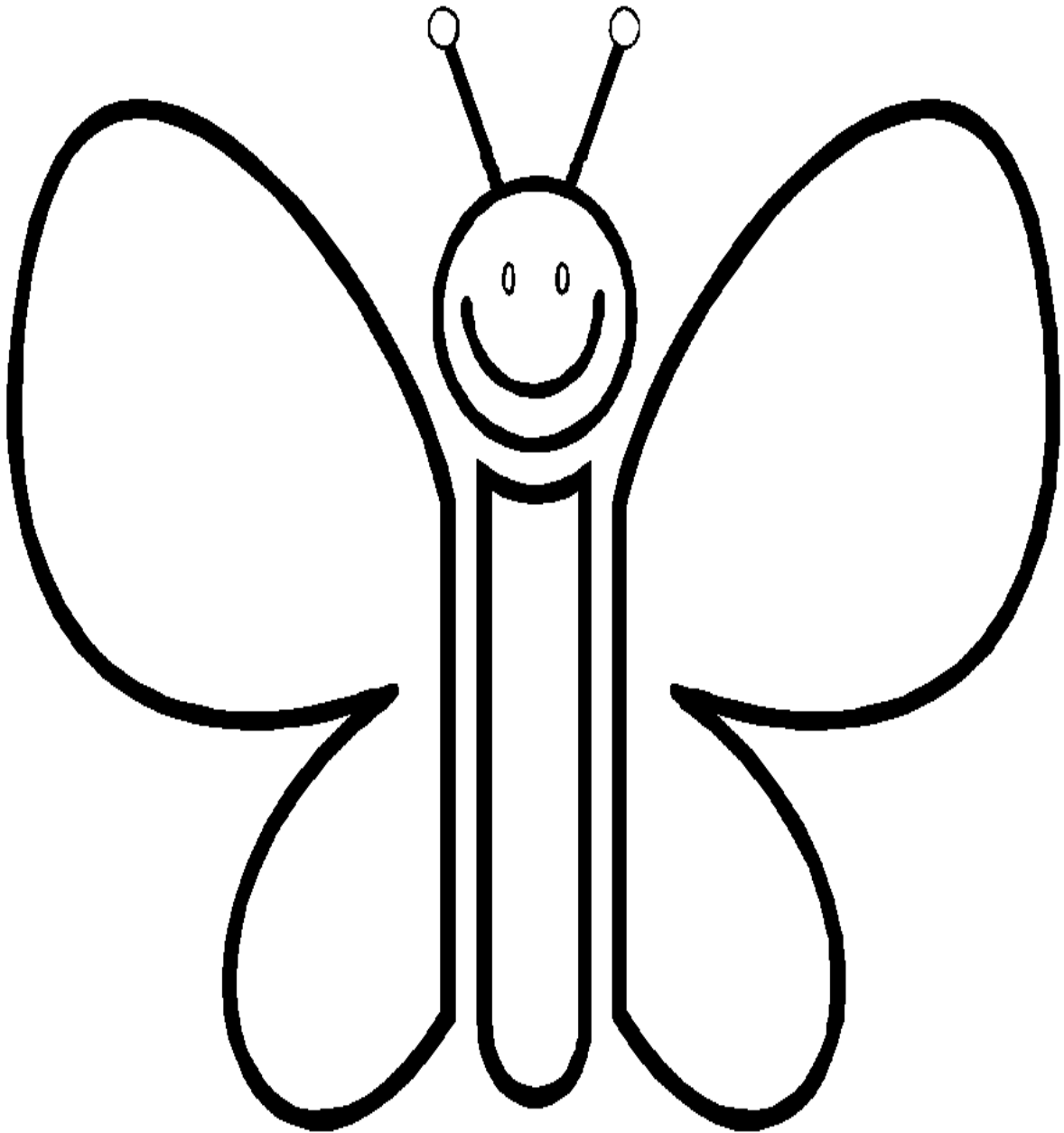
- **Completes the worksheets independently .**

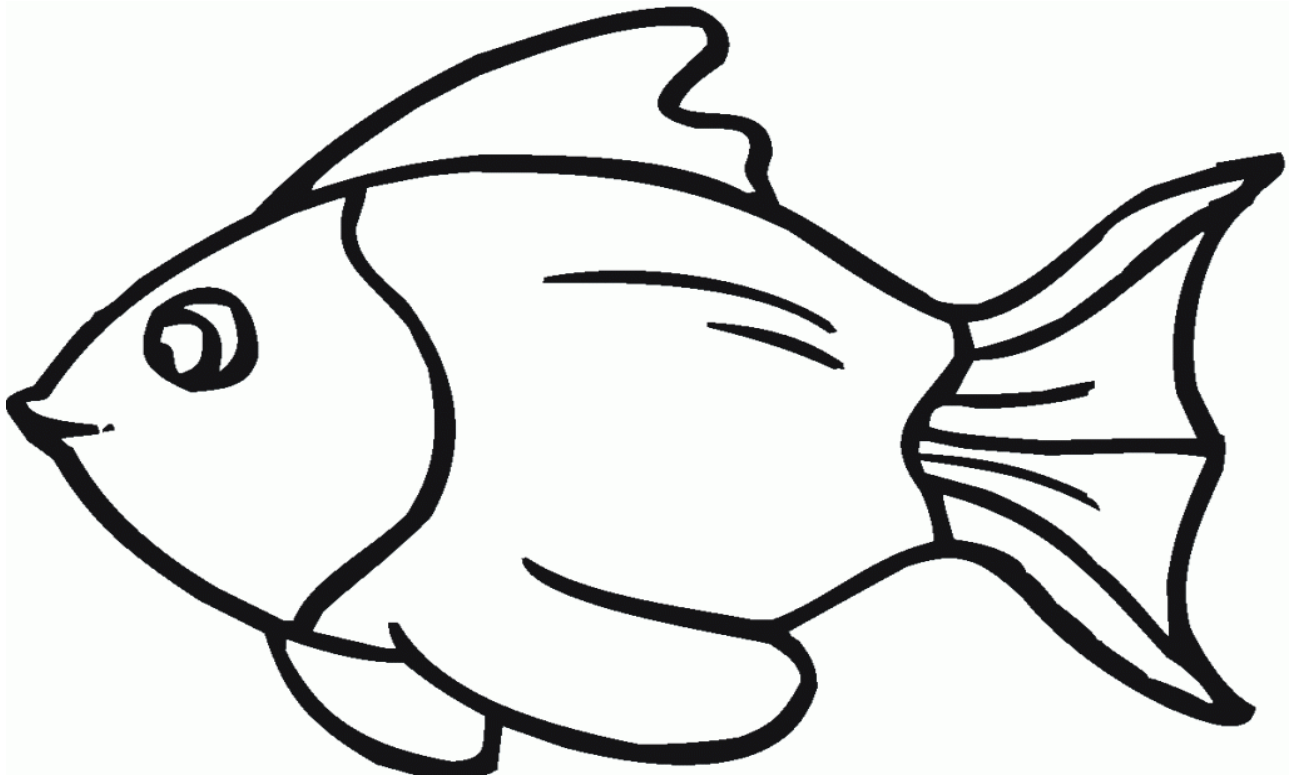
Prepare a flash card (size 6"6") according to your roll number below:

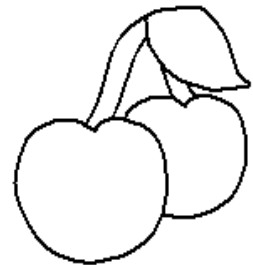
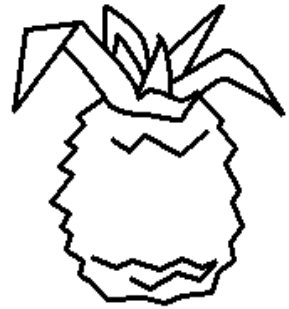
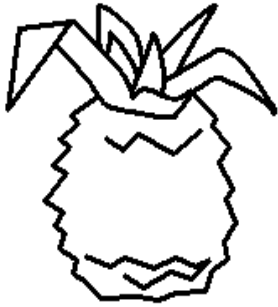


Follow the numbers from 1 to 10 to lead the baby to his blanket.

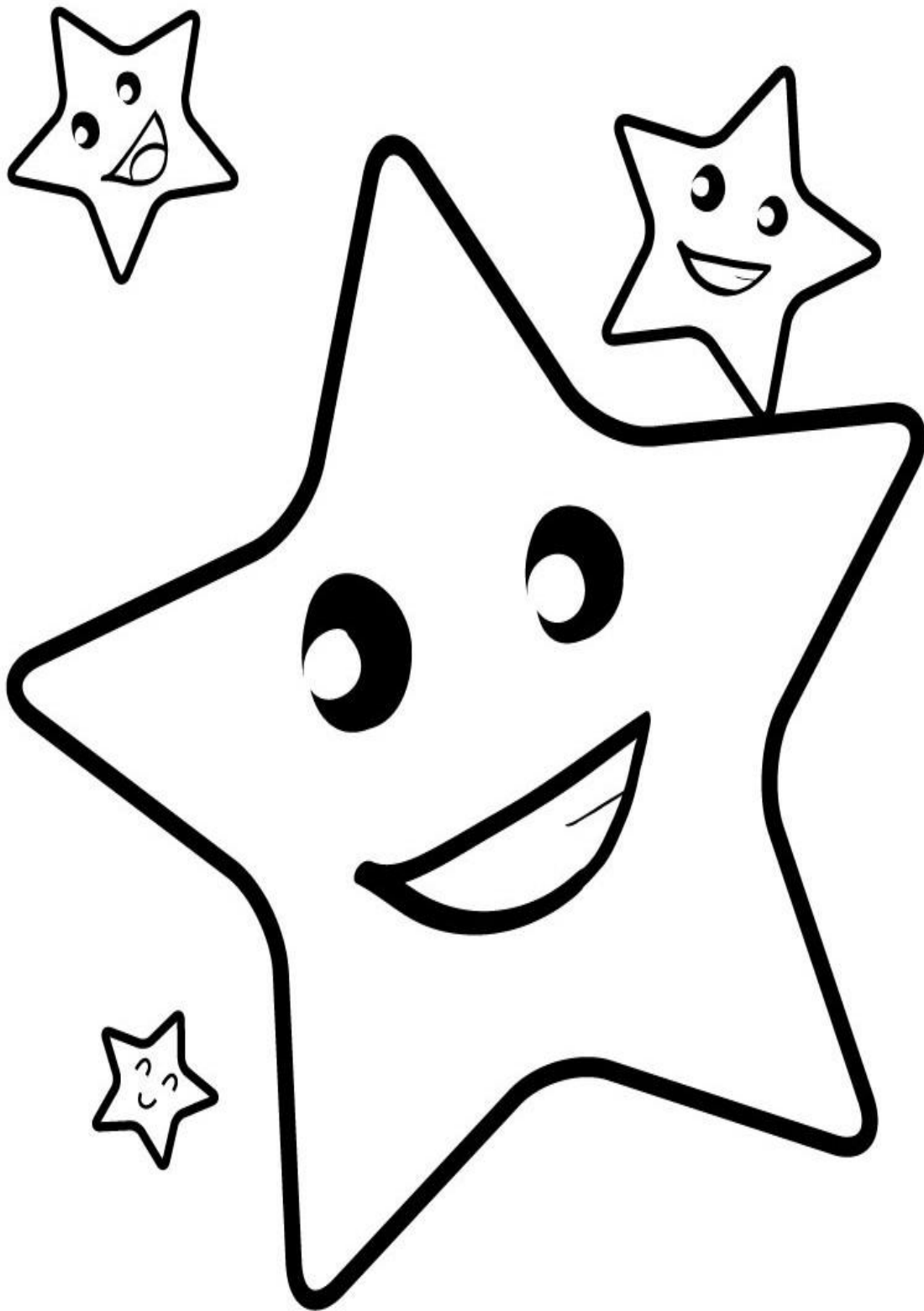
The maze is a grid-based path starting from a baby and ending at a blanket. The path is defined by numbers 1 through 10:

- 1:** A horizontal line pointing left from the baby.
- 2:** A vertical line going down from the end of step 1.
- 3:** A horizontal line going right from the end of step 2.
- 4:** A vertical line going down from the end of step 3.
- 5:** A horizontal line going right from the end of step 4.
- 6:** A vertical line going down from the end of step 5.
- 7:** A horizontal line going right from the end of step 6.
- 8:** A vertical line going down from the end of step 7.
- 9:** A horizontal line going right from the end of step 8.
- 10:** A vertical line going down from the end of step 9 to the blanket.

## Sun Paper Plate Craft



This is a simple craft made from a paper plate and a child's handprint cutouts.

- WHAT WILL YOU NEED
- A paper plate
- Yellow chart paper
- Scissors
- Glue (or a stapler)
- Crayons, paint or markers



Paint the back side of a paper plate yellow.



Trace a child's hand on yellow chart paper about 7 times.

Cut out the tracings.



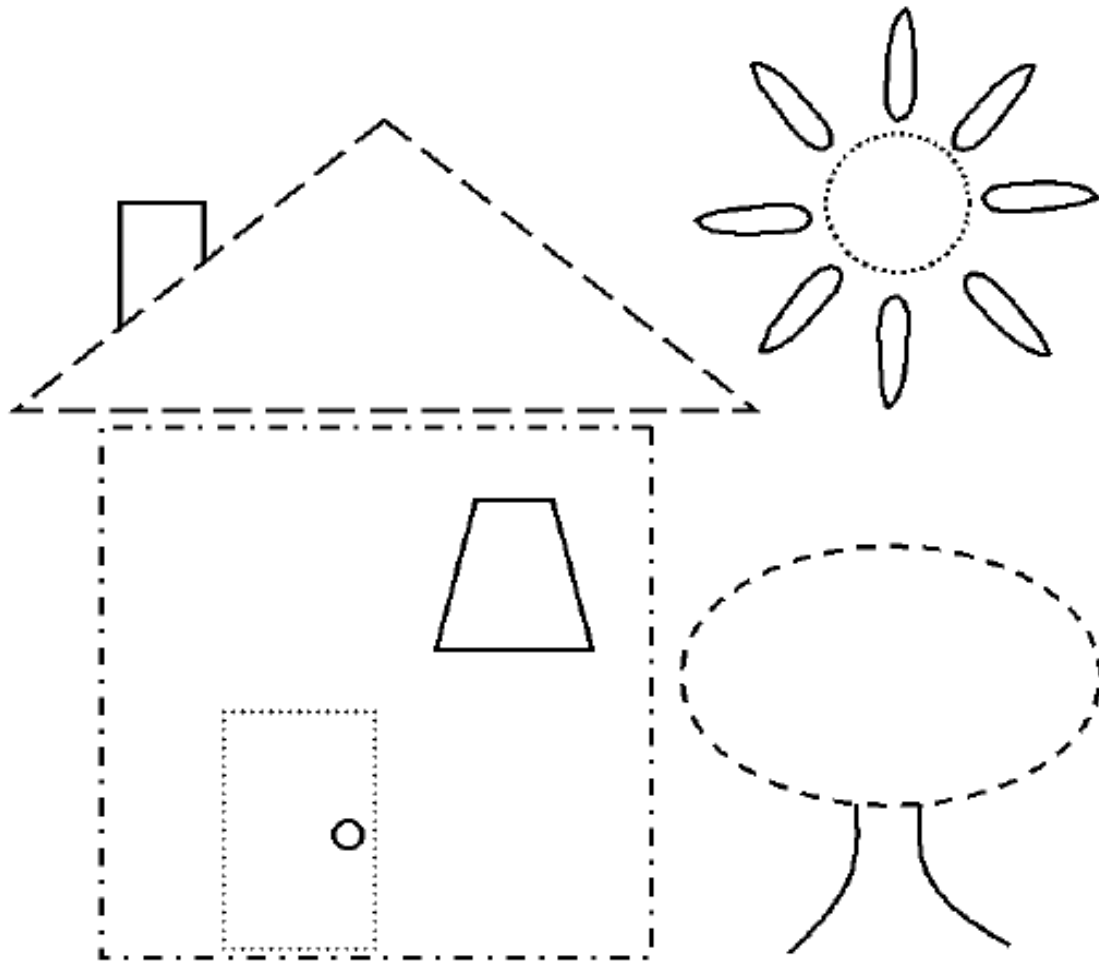
Glue or staple the handprint tracings to the paper plate - the fingers are the sun's rays.
